A resident student is defined as one who resides in this district with either or both of his/her parents or guardians with the parents or guardians having the intention of making this district their legal residence. If a child is not residing with his/her legal parents, legal guardianship should be obtained. Nebraska statutes require notice to the parent or guardian in disciplinary matters and it is also essential that the school have someone with legal responsibility who can be notified in events such as need for medical attention, etc. The burden of proof as to the establishment of legal residency rests with the child and the parents.

The district may allow a pupil whose residency in the district ceases during a school year to continue attending school for the remainder of that semester without payment of tuition.

The district may also allow, upon written requests of parents who have moved from the district, a student to complete his/her senior year in Norfolk if he/she has been in attendance in Norfolk Senior High School the previous two years. The Board of Education may waive the tuition requirement in such cases. Enrollment of students in this category in Norfolk Senior High must be approved by the Senior High School principal before being brought to the attention of the Board of Education

If a person does not agree with a decision of the superintendent as to tuition-free attendance, then such person can submit the question to the Board of Education for final determination. The person making such a request shall assume the burden proving that district admission policies were applied incorrectly.
