1. **Board of Trustees scholarship.** This is full tuition and renewable for four years. Must score a 25 or above on ACT or above 1700 on SAT. Deadline: January 15, 2010
2. **Governor's Opportunity Award.** This is 1/2 tuition and renewable for four years. Must score between a 21 and a 24 on ACT or between 1500 and 1650 on the SAT. Deadline: December 1, 2009
3. **Davis-Chambers scholarship.** Based on financial need. Deadline: December 1, 2009
