SCHOLARSHIPS

Gates Millennium Scholars program has the following criteria:

- *applicant must be African American, American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian Pacific Islander or Hispanic American
- *applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher
- *applicant has demonstrated leadership and community service
- *applicant must be Pell grant eligible

It is recommended that application forms be completed on-line

The deadline is January 11, 2010. Additional information and directions are available in the counseling center. See a counselor if you would like more information on this program.

Central Community College in Hastings Nebraska has a sponsorship and scholarship program for students interested in becoming Heavy Construction and Agricultural Diesel Technicians. Nebraska State College System (Wayne, Chadron, and Peru State colleges) *scholarships are on-line at www.nscs.edu under the scholarship tab.* They include the following:

1. Board of Trustees scholarship. This is full tuition and renewable for four years. Must score a 25 or above on ACT or above 1700 on SAT. Deadline: January 15, 2010
2. Governor's Opportunity Award. This is 1/2 tuition and renewable for four years. Must score between a 21 and a 24 on ACT or between 1500 and 1650 on the SAT. Deadline: December 1, 2009
3. Davis-Chambers scholarship. Based on financial need. Deadline: December 1, 2009
